COMMUNITY EDUCATION*

Description: Represent Refuge House at Community Events and provide technical assistance with presentations in various venues.

Qualification: Active in the community, willingness to reach out to people, and **willingness to network on behalf of Refuge House.** Friendly and outgoing personality. Excellent Communication skills. Ability to work in diverse settings.

CHILDREN'S ADVOCATE**

Description: Working directly with children who have experienced trauma and/or are currently in crisis and abusive situations.

Qualification: Experience in childcare setting and understanding of how **trauma presents itself in children.** Excellent communication skills and bilingual individual preferred.

COURTHOUSE ADVOCATE**

Description: Working directly with survivors who are currently in crisis and abusive situations within a criminal justice setting.

Qualification: Available during regular weekday business hours. Experience with law or criminal justice (counseling a plus). **Ability to be assertive** and communicate with court officials and law enforcement on behalf of survivors in a professional manner.

EMERGENCY SHELTER**

Description: Working directly with survivors from underserved and diverse populations in time of crisis in the Refuge House shelter.

Qualification: Experience with counseling and office management. Ability to help survivors and fill out paperwork in a **fast-paced environment.** Excellent communication skills, detail-oriented, and bilingual individual preferred. Must have reliable transportation and access to phone at all times.

RAPE CRISIS**

Description: Working directly with survivors who are currently in crisis and abusive situations within a **hospital setting.**

Qualification: Experience with law or criminal justice (counseling a plus). Ability to work communicate with health and law enforcement professionals on behalf of survivors. Must have flexible schedule and commit to working **36 hours per month.**
